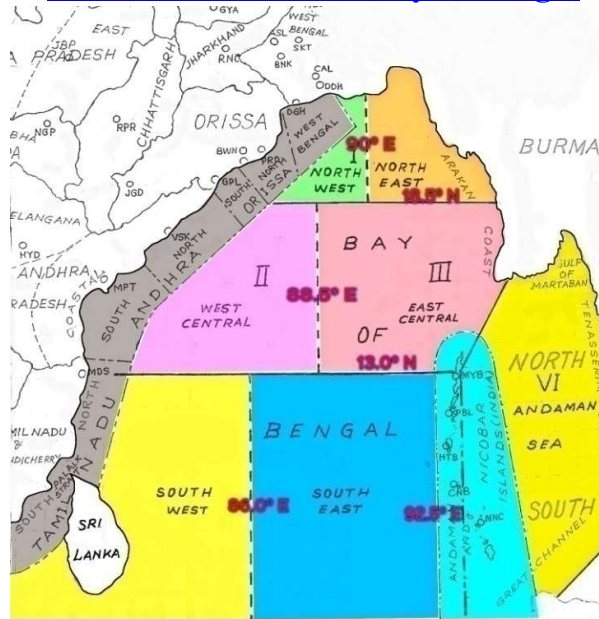




Sea Area Bulletins of Bay of Bengal



AURORA OBSERVATION Date: Thursday 06th August 2020

Synoptic Situation: Yesterday's trough of low from Northwest Bay of Bengal to Eastcentral Bay across Westcentral Bay persists. A low pressure area is likely to develop over West Central & adjoining North Bay of Bengal around 9th August, 2020. South West monsoon moderate to strong over Northeast Bay of Bengal, South Bay of Bengal & Andaman Sea.

PART THREE

◆ NORTH BAY

Wind: South to Southwesterly; 15 to 20 knots gusting to 25 knots.

Weather: Fairly widespread rain or thundershowers.

Visibility: Moderate becoming poor in heavy rain.

Sea Condition: Slight to Moderate becoming rough in gusts.

◆ SOUTH EAST BAY & ANDAMAN SEA (WEST OF LONG 95° E)

Wind: Mainly Southwesterly; 15 to 20 knots
gusting to 25 knots.

Weather: Widespread rain or thundershowers.

Visibility: Good becoming moderate in rain.

Sea Condition: Slight to moderate becoming
rough in gusts.

◆ EAST CENTRAL BAY (WEST OF LONG 92°E)

Wind: Mainly Southwesterly; 20 to 25 knots.

Weather: Widespread rain or thundershowers.

Visibility: Moderate becoming poor in heavy rain.

Sea Condition: Moderate to rough.

◆ SOUTH WEST BAY

Wind: Mainly Southwesterly; 20 to 25 knots gusting to 30 knots.

Weather: Scattered rain or thundershowers.

Visibility: Good becoming moderate in rain.

Sea Condition: Moderate to rough becoming very rough in gusts.

◆ WEST CENTRAL BAY

Wind: Mainly Southwesterly; 25 to 30 knots.

Weather: Fairly widespread rain or thundershowers.

Visibility: Moderate becoming poor in heavy rain.

Sea Condition: Rough to very rough.
