TTT CYCLONE WARNING OVER BAY OF BENGAL ON 270000 UTC AAA

The Cyclonic Storm "Montha" [Pronunciation : Mon-Tha] over Southwest & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal moved northwestwards with a speed of 15 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centered at 0530 hrs IST of today, the 27th October 2025, over Southwest & adjoining areas of Westcentral and southeast Bay of Bengal, near latitude 12.2°N & longitude 85.3°E, about 560 km east-southeast of Chennai (Tamil Nadu), 620 km south-southeast of Kakinada (Andhra Pradesh), 650 km south-southeast of Visakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh), 790 km south of Gopalpur (Odisha) and 810 km west of Port Blair (Andaman & Nicobar Islands).

It is likely to continue to move northwestwards over southwest & adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal during next 12 hours, then north-northwestwards and intensify into a severe cyclonic storm by morning of 28th October. Continuing to move further north-northwestwards, it is very likely to cross Andhra Pradesh coast between Machilipatnam and Kalingapatnam around Kakinada during evening/night of 28th October as a severe cyclonic storm with a maximum sustained wind speed of 90-100 kmph gusting to 110 kmph.
