Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into remaining parts of Southwest Bay of Bengal, some parts of Westcentral and some more parts of Eastcentral Bay of Bengal today, the 04th June, 2021. The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) now passes through lat. 14°N/ Long. 60°E, lat. 14.5°N/ Long. 70°E, Karwar, Harapanahalli (Vijayanagaram district), Anantapur, Arogyavaram, Vellore, Nagapattinam, lat. 12°N/ Long. 83°E, 15°N/89°E and 18.5°N/94°E. Southwest Monsoon weak over South East Bay of Bengal and Andaman sea; weak to moderate over South west Bay of Bengal, many parts of East Central Bay of Bengal, some parts of West Central Bay of Bengal. Weather seasonal over rest parts of Bay of Bengal.
