TTT DEEP DEPRESSION WARNING BAY OF BENGAL 250300 UTC

Part Two

The deep depression over Eastcentral Bay of Bengal moved nearly northwards with a speed of 17 kmph during past 06 hours and lay centered at 0830 hrs IST of 25th May, 2024 over the same region near latitude 18.0°N and longitude 89.7°E, about 440 km south-southwest of Khepupara (Bangladesh), 440 km south-southeast of Sagar Islands (West Bengal) and 480 km south-southeast of Canning (West Bengal). It is very likely to continue to move nearly northwards and intensify into a Cyclonic Storm over eastcentral & adjoining north Bay of Bengal around 25th May evening. Continuing to move further northwards, it would intensify into a Severe Cyclonic Storm by 26th May morning and cross Bangladesh & adjoining West Bengal coasts between Sagar Island and Khepupara by 26th May midnight as a Severe Cyclonic Storm with wind speed of 110-120 gusting to 135 kmph.
