Yesterday's Low Pressure Area over central parts of South Bay of Bengal & adjoining East Equatorial Indian Ocean now lies as a Well Marked Low Pressure area over Southwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining East Equatorial Indian Ocean. It is likely to move northwestwards and concentrate into a depression over Southwest Bay of Bengal off Sri Lanka coast during next 48 hours. Thereafter, it is likely to move westsouthwest wards towards Comorin Area across Sri Lanka. Weather seasonal over rest Bay of Bengal and Andaman sea.
