Yesterday's Low Pressure Area over Central parts of South Bay of Bengal and adjoining Equatorial Indian Ocean persists. It is likely to become well-marked Low Pressure Area during next 24 hours and concentrate into a depression during subsequent 24 hours. It is very likely to move west-northwestwards towards Sri Lanka coast during next 24 hours and towards Tamil Nadu Coast during subsequent 24 hours. Weather seasonal over rest Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.
