TTT CYCLONE "DITAH" WARNING OVER COASTAL SRILANKA AND ADJOINING SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL ON 271500 UTC

Part Two

The Cyclonic Storm Ditwah [Pronunciation: Ditwah] over coastal Sri Lanka and adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal moved north-northwestwards with the speed of 13 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centered at 2030 hrs IST of today, the 27th November 2025 over the same region, near latitude 7.7°N and longitude 81.5°E, about 20 km west of Batticaloa (Sri Lanka), 100 km south-southeast of Trincomalee (Sri Lanka), 180 km north-northeast of Hambantota (Sri Lanka), 510 km south-southeast of Puducherry (India) and 610 km south-southeast of Chennai (India). It is very likely to continue to move north-northwestwards across Sri Lanka coast & adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal and reach over southwest Bay of Bengal near North Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and adjoining south Andhra Pradesh coasts by early morning of 30th November.
