Part Two

Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into some more parts of south Bay of Bengal, remaining parts of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Andaman Sea and some parts of Eastcentral Bay of Bengal today, the 24th May. The Northern Limit of Monsoon passes through 05°N/60°E, 06°N/70°E, 7°N/75°E, 8°/80°E, 11°N/85°E, 13.5°N/90°E and 17°N/95°E. Conditions are favourable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon over some more parts of South Bay of Bengal, Central Bay of Bengal and some parts of Northeast Bay of Bengal during next 2 days. The depression over central Bay of Bengal moved northeastwards during past 03 hours, and lay centered at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 24th May, 2024 over the same region near latitude 15.5°N and longitude 88.7°E, about 730 km south-southwest of Khepupara (Bangladesh) and 750 km south of Canning (West Bengal). It is very likely to continue to move northeastwards and intensify further into a cyclonic storm over eastcentral Bay of Bengal by 25th May morning. Subsequently, it would move nearly northwards, intensify into a severe cyclonic storm by 25th night. Continuing to move nearly northward, it is very likely to cross Bangladesh and adjoining West Bengal coasts between Sagar Island and Khepupara around 26th May midnight as a severe cyclonic storm. Yesterday's cyclonic circulation over west Bihar & neighbourhood between 3.1 & 5.8 km above mean sea level has become less marked.
