A Low-Pressure Area has formed over Northeast & adjoining Eastcentral Bay of Bengal. It is likely to become a Well Marked Low Pressure Area and move northwestwards towards north Odisha & adjoining West Bengal coasts during next 48 hours. Southwest monsoon moderate to strong over South Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea; weak to moderate over West Central Bay and Northwest Bay of Bengal.
