The Northern Limit of Southwest Monsoon continues to pass through 5°N/67°E, 6°N/72°E, 5.5°N/80°E, 8°N/85°E, 12.5°N/90°E, 16.0°N/93°E and 18.0°N/94.5°E. Conditions are favorable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon over some parts of south & Eastcentral Bay of Bengal and some part of Northeast Bay of Bengal during next 48 hours. South West monsoon Moderate over Andaman Sea, Some parts of South Bay of Bengal and East Central Bay of Bengal. Weather Seasonal over rest Bay of Bengal.
