Part 4	31 July 2026 Weather Surface Chart 0300 UTC The Depression over central Vidarbha and adjoining south Madhya Pradesh near latitude 21.1°N and longitude 78.1°E. The Monsoon trough at mean sea level now passes through Jaisalmer, Udaipur, Indore, centre of Depression over Western Vidarbha and adjoining south Madhya Pradesh, Gopalpur thence southeastwards towards Central Bay of Bengal at mean sea level. The off-Shore trough at mean sea level from South Gujarat to North Kerala persists.
