

Synoptic Situation: Yesterday's Low Pressure Area over Northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining north coastal Odisha now moved inland. Yesterday's trough over Northwest Bay of Bengal now lies over Northwest to Northeast Bay of Bengal. Southwest monsoon moderate to strong over West Central Bay of Bengal, Southwest Bay of Bengal and moderate over East Central Bay, Southeast Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.

♦ NORTH BAY

Wind: South to Southwesterly; 15 to 20 knots gusting to 25 knots.

Weather: Widespread rain or thundershowers.

Visibility: Good becoming moderate in rain.

Sea Condition: Slight to moderate becoming rough in gusts.

◆ SOUTH EAST BAY AND ANDAMAN SEA (WEST OF LONG 95° E)

Wind: Mainly Southwesterly; 15 to 20 knots.

Weather: Scattered rain or thundershowers.

Visibility: Good becoming moderate in rain.

Sea Condition: Slight to moderate.

◆ EAST CENTRAL BAY (WEST OF LONG 92°E)

Wind: South to Southwesterly; 15 to 20 knots.
