

Synoptic Situation: Yesterday's Trough at mean sea level over North Bay of Bengal persists. Southwest monsoon moderate to strong over West Central Bay; moderate over Southwest Bay of Bengal; weak to moderate over East Central Bay, Southeast Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.

PART THREE

NORTH WEST BAY

Wind: Mainly Southwesterly; 15 to 20 knots gusting to 25 knots.

Weather: Scattered rain or thundershowers.

Visibility: Good becoming moderate in rain.

Sea Condition: Slight to moderate becoming rough in gusts.

◆ SOUTH EAST BAY & ANDAMAN SEA (WEST OF LONG 95° E)

Wind: Southwest to Westerly; 10 to 15 knots.

Weather: Isolated rain or thundershowers.

Visibility: Good becoming moderate in rain.

Sea Condition: Smooth to slight.

◆ EAST CENTRAL BAY (WEST OF LONG 92°E)

Wind: Southwest to Westerly; 10 to 15 knots.
