Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into some more parts of South Arabian Sea, entire Maldives & adjoining areas of Lakshadweep and some more parts of Comorin area. The Northern Limit of Southwest Monsoon now passesthrough 9.5°N/60°E, 9.5°N/70°E, 9.5°N/73°E, 7.5°N/77°E, 8.0°N/83°E, 12.5°N/90°E, 16.0°N/93°E and 18.0°N/94.5°E. Southwest monsoon moderate to strong over Andaman Sea., some parts of South Bay of Bengal and some parts of East Central Bay of BEngal. Weather seasonal over rest Bay of Bengal.
