**PART ONE:-** No storm warning.

**PART TWO:-** The monsoon trough at mean sea level passes through northeast Bay of Bengal and extends upto 1.5 km above mean sea level .Southwest monsoon moderate to strong over Southwest Bay of Bengal; moderate over Southeast Bay and Andaman Sea; weak to moderate over North Bay and Central Bay of Bengal.

**PART THREE: AREA FORECAST VALID FROM 30 2100 UTC TO 01 0900 UTC**

<b>NORTH BAY.</b>	<b>WIND VISIBILITY</b>	South to Southwesterly; 10 to 15 knots. Good becoming moderate in rain.
<b>CENTRAL BAY (WEST OF LONG 92°E)</b>	<b>WIND VISIBILITY</b>	Mainly Southwesterly; 10 to 15 knots. Good becoming moderate in rain.
<b>SOUTHWEST BAY.</b>	<b>WIND VISIBILITY</b>	Mainly Southwesterly; 15 to 20 knots gusting to 25 knots. Good becoming poor in heavy rain.
<b>SOUTHEAST BAY &amp; ANDAMAN SEA (West of long 95°E)</b>	<b>WIND VISIBILITY</b>	South to Southwesterly; 15 to 20 knots. Good becoming moderate in rain.
