

Heavy Rainfall Warning based on 0300 UTC of 11th September, 2024


(i) Rainfall warning


- East Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places is very likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places on 11th; heavy to very heavy rainfall at few places on 12th and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 13th and 14th September.
- West Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at many places is very likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places on11th & 12th; heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places on 13th & 14th September and heavy rainfall at a few places on 15th September.
- West Uttar Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at many places is very likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places on11th, 12th and 13th and heavy rainfall at a few places on 14th & 15th September.
- East Uttar Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at many places is very likely with heavy rainfall at isolated places on 11th; heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places on12th and heavy rainfall at a few places on 13th, 14th & 15th September.
- East Rajasthan: Light to moderate rainfall at many places is very likely with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places on 11th, 12th & 13th and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 14th & 15th September.
- West Rajasthan: Light to moderate rainfall at many places is very likely with heavy rainfall at a few places on 11th & 12th September.

Warning Graphics










- Action may be taken based on ORANGE AND RED COLOUR warnings.

Flash Flood Guidance



East Madhya Pradesh - Chhatarpur, Damoh, Narshimapura, Sagar and Tikamgarh districts.

West Madhya Pradesh - Ashoknagar, Raisen, Videsha and Hoshangabad districts. Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over AoC as shown in map due to expected.
