

Heavy Rainfall Warning based on 0000 UTC of 14th August, 2026

Odisha: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely over north interior Odisha on 14th-17th August.

Chhattisgarh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places is very likely over north Chhattisgarh on 14th & 15th August and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 16th & 17th August.

Jharkhand: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 14th and heavy rainfall at isolated places during 15th - 17th August.

Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 14th August; heavy to very heavy rainfall on 15th & 16th August.

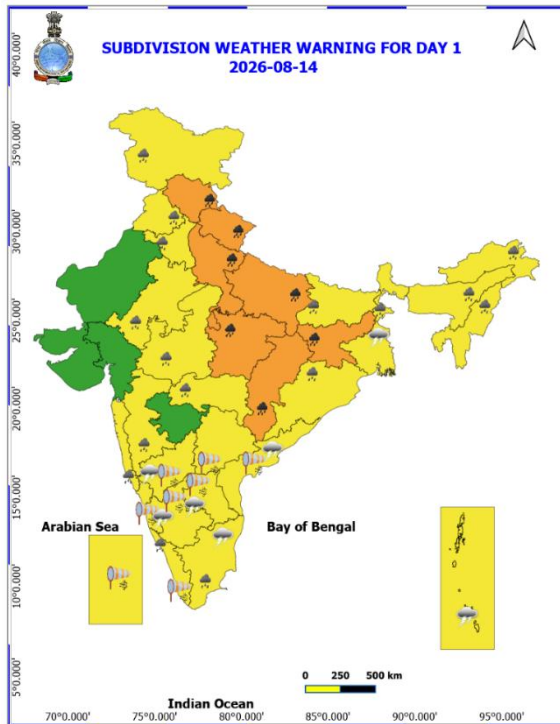
Bihar: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is likely on 14th & 17th August.

East Uttar Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places on 14th and heavy rainfall at isolated places during 15th-17th August.

West Uttar Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 14th and heavy rainfall at isolated places during 15th-17th August.

East Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places during 14th -17th August.

Uttarakhand: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 14th August, heavy rainfall at isolated places on 15th August and heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places during 16th -17th August.

Persistent Flash Flood Threat (PFFT) till 1130 IST of 14-08-2026:

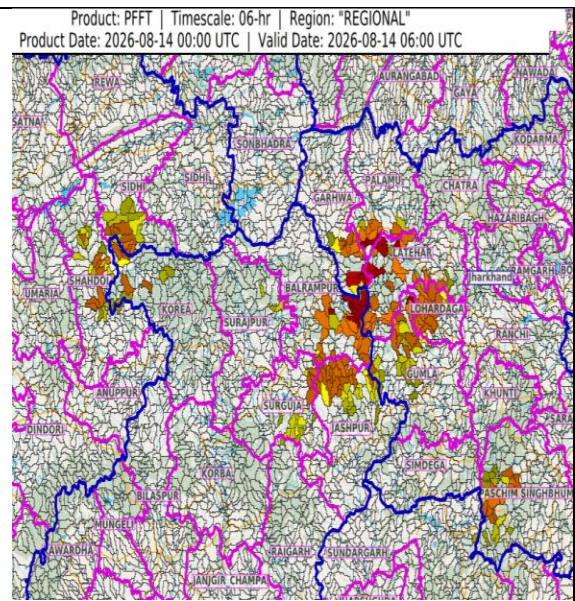
Low to Moderate flash flood threat likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 6 hours.

Chhattisgarh: Balrampur, Jashpur, Koriya, Surajpur and Surguja districts

Jharkhand: Garhwa, Latehar, Lohardaga, Palamu, Gumla and West Singhbhum districts

East Madhya Pradesh: Sidhi and Shahdol districts

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over Area of Concern (AoC) as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 6 hours.

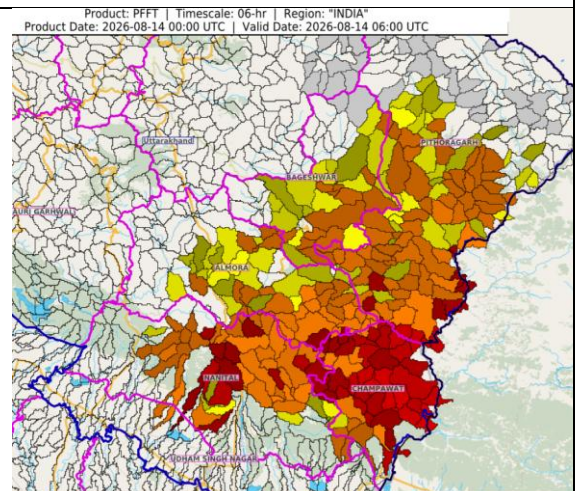


Persistent Flash Flood Threat (PFFT) till 1130 IST of 14-08-2026:

Low to Moderate flash flood threat likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 6 hours.

Uttarakhand: Almora, Bageshwar, Nainital, Pithoragarh and Champawat districts

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over Area of Concern (AoC) as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 6 hours.



Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 0530 IST of 15-08-2026:

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

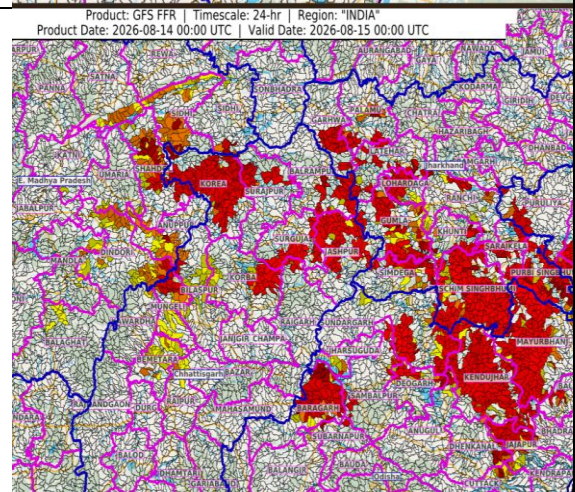

Jharkhand: Simdega, West Singhbhum, East Singhbhum, Gumla, Khunti, Lohardaga, Seraikela-Kharsawan, Latehar, Ranchi, Palamu and Garhwa districts

Odisha: Bargarh, Jharsuguda, Sambalpur, Sonapur, Sundargarh, Deogarh, Keonjhar, Mayurbhanj, Dhenkanal, Jajpur, Balasore and Bhadrak districts

Gangetic West Bengal: Purulia, West Midnapore and Bankura districts



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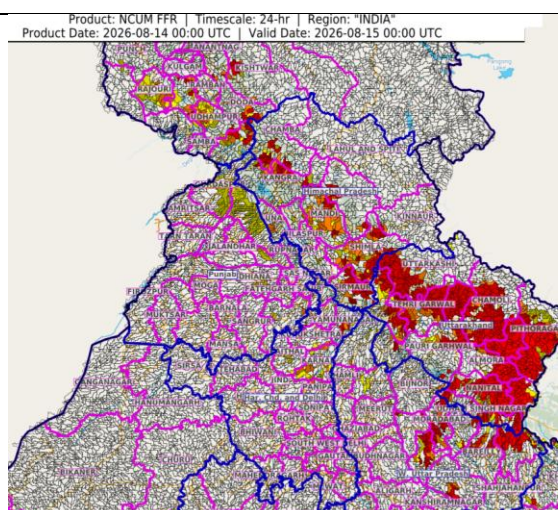
